
It turns out that the bride's suitcase was in her father's car and we asked him for it four times, but he said he would bring it

Have you ever wondered why wedding photos with a peculiar "blurry" touch have become so frequent on social networks?

Photography is an art form that has evolved over time, adapting to new technologies and market trends. But what is behind this trend?

Let's talk about motion blur, this photographic technique that uses slow shutter speeds in cameras to capture the fluidity and action of the moment. Why has it gained so much popularity? Mainly because it has the power to transport the viewer to an instant that is perceived as unique and real.

At a wedding, where everything happens so fast for the bride and groom, movement becomes a recognizable ingredient that adds authenticity and emotion to your photos.

Although it is not a new technique, it has made a strong comeback in recent years,





reflecting a change in the perception of beauty and aesthetics in wedding photography.

We know that people connect better with images that are perceived as human and imperfect. However, to what extent can we allow that connection to happen if we can barely recognize what we are seeing? It's important to know that some things become questionably "blurry" when the pressure to stand out on networks comes into play.

Unsharp photos have to be the most controversial photographic trend at the moment, one that can generate love and hate with very few options in between, that's why our recommendation for couples when choosing their photographer is to ask to see more than one portfolio. You should ask as many questions as you feel necessary, and above all communicate the expectation you have for your photographic coverage, so you can make a better decision.





This type of photography, along with black and white photos, snapshots with direct flash, and roll photography, are also part of a retro wave that envelops us in an atmosphere of nostalgia and emotionality.

So who could resist the allure of this 80s-inspired trend? What we must remember is what makes this era so special; a vision that revolved around experimentation and individuality in culture and fashion.

We find that this style adds a special charm to the visual narrative of the celebration, the atmosphere of lights and movement in the celebration will be reflected in an original way and we are sure it will be a good idea to ask your photographer to include them.

Fashion always passes, your engagement is for life.



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


When starting the process of organizing a wedding, I consider that a fundamental part the professional of the flowers, coordinator or event designer as such, is to know the color that identifies the bride and groom. Undoubtedly, I tell you that from that moment the magic of creating and designing by and for the bride and groom starts. Based on the color it will be possible to establish how to decorate according to the chosen space, the schedule, and above all, the style. My fundamental advice for the bride and groom when they are ready to talk with decoration their coordinator or designer is to be clear about COLOR.

I share with you some recommendations on how to make a mental exercise of color and arrive with a clearer palette to the meeting with the person in charge of this mission.



1. THE ATMOSPHERE: Color undoubtedly helps to create the atmosphere. If you are romantic and dreamy, go for pastel tones. Cheerful and vibrant go hand in hand with oranges and yellows. For modern and minimalist marry in white with black and gray. Shades of green are for bohemian and eclectic brides and grooms. And for traditional and classic environments do not abandon white which is your best ally.



2. THE SEARCH FOR INSPIRATION: Look at the colors of flowers, sunsets, seasons, seascapes, forests, etc. Keep an eye on wedding magazines and blogs. Enter museums and virtual galleries to observe paintings and photographs. Don't forget that technology has put social media at your fingertips and see how Instagram, Pinterest, etc. blow your mind and help you ground it. And don't overlook personal interests and hobbies which are often the winners in choosing the color.







3. SEASON: If you live in a city where the seasons of the year are very of the year are well marked, let that help you to find the color that prevails in your environment during the date of your wedding.



4. THE SITE: I think it is crucial to stop and look around outdoors or in an enclosed room. The "vibe" of the place will help you see what colors go there. The color palette of earth and greens look out of place in a rustic setting. If the site is modern and minimalist, a more sober or even monochromatic color palette would be the best choice.



I can only say that the most important thing here is that the bride and groom are clear that this is their day and that what they choose should go hand in hand with their personal tastes and preferences. You will have to see many options and above all opinions, but the most important thing here is you. The color or colors to use in the wedding are the best way to express your style and above all your personality.

3. Custom dance floors

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The famous American actress Grace Kelly: the spring of 1956 saw her become a princess, when she married the most eligible bachelor of the time, Prince Rainier III.

Grace Kelly and Prince Rainier of Monaco tied the knot on April 28th of that year. The whole wedding had a halo of fairy tale, mystique and romanticism. Grace wore one of the most inspiring dresses in the world of romance.

The dress took exactly 6 weeks to make and involved the work of 35 seamstresses who did not stop for a minute. They worked day and night non-stop with the only goal of getting the dress ready for the big day in a timely manner.





The design was by Helen Rose, one of Grace Kelly's favorite dressmakers. Helen was the one who worked at her side at the film studios, Metro Golden Mayer. Although Helen knew perfectly the silhouette of the future princess and had already designed several pieces for Grace in her films, she clearly knew that this was not just another dress but "THE dress". Helen's inspiration is clear to see, it was perfect and fit the silhouette like a glove. Helen has confessed that it was the most expensive dress she had ever made up to the time it was made.





Curious facts

The lace alone was 100 years old, a creation of silk taffeta, Brussels lace and pearls. A delicate fitted model, with French lace on the second layer and a wide skirt with a sash that perfectly marked the waist.

The texture of an angelic veil completed an outfit that would undoubtedly go down in history.

The beautiful costume consisted of a sweetheart bodice, attached to a wide skirt with two lace petticoats. It required 25 meters of silk taffeta, 100 meters of silk mesh and about 12 meters of Brussels lace to make. The outfit was completed with a headdress embroidered with pearls to match the shoes and a small bible that set the trend in the following years. The bouquet was made of lilies of the valley, a flower that the princess loved.

An estimated cost today for the dress is around 5000 USD, perhaps at that time the sum would have amounted to a value of 10,000 USD, which for that time was a very important amount.

It was definitely a dress made for a princess. It was a wedding that everyone talked about. Many brides even to this day copied what happened at the royal wedding. Flowers, cakes and music, but without a doubt Helen Rose was blessed to create a personalized romantic style that marked an era and that many brides still desire today.

Grace & Prince Rainier were the first great fairy tale. A tale that was truncated perhaps because of the pearls that this dress wore. The belief of wearing or not wearing pearls in the wedding dress comes from ancient Rome. Although they were a symbol of high economic status, they linked it with the tears of an angel and said that this would fill your marriage with tears.

"Dive with us into the story of Costa Rica's DJ Fede Fernández as he shares with us his exciting journey in the wedding universe. From the most emotional moments to the hottest trends, discover how this talented professional has left his mark on every wedding celebration."

How was the dream of being a DJ born and since when?

Since I was 4 years old. I studied music, but it was at 13 when I discovered the fascinating world of DJs by combining music with technology. Experiencing the feeling of being responsible for making people dance for the first time was something that instantly captivated me and pushed me forward.

What is your main musical style and how do you define it?

I consider myself an open format DJ. The main thing for me is to read the audience

and make them have fun on the dance floor, regardless of the musical genre.

What inspired you to become a DJ and how did you start your career?

The passion for music and the desire to share that passion with others were my main inspirations. I started my career playing at local events and friends' parties, which allowed me to build my way into the music industry.

What technological tools or equipment do you use in your presentations?

I use high quality equipment, such as the pioneer DDJ-ZX, which allows me to offer an exceptional musical experience to my audience.





Do you have any special ritual or preparation before going on stage?

Before going on stage, I usually listen to music from different genres, which helps me get in tune and enjoy the songs even more when I share them with the guests.

What has been your most memorable performance or event so far and why?

I have had the privilege of playing at festivals like PIC NIC, parties like MOONDANCE, and at incredible weddings in Costa Rica, which are the parties that motivate me the most, as creating unforgettable moments for the bride and groom and their guests is a gratifying experience.

How do you keep up to date on trends and developments in the music industry?

I immerse myself in music constantly, from the time I wake up to the time I go to bed. I'm always looking and listening to different genres to keep up with the latest trends and news.



How do you think the role of the DJ in the music industry has evolved in recent years?

The role of the DJ has evolved significantly, becoming a key figure in the music industry. Now, DJs are able to fill stadiums and create unforgettable experiences for their audience.

Do you have any advice for those who are interested in pursuing a career as a DJ?

My advice would be to follow your passion for music. Those who DJ for the love of music are already the best DJs, as authenticity and passion are what really connects with the audience.

Fede Fernández shares with us the essence of his greatest passion, a passion that he has nurtured for many years and that, without a moment's hesitation, he would choose again if he had the opportunity to live again. For him, being a DJ goes beyond a simple profession; it is a lifestyle, a form of expression that allows him to connect with people's emotions through music. At every event, on every dance floor, he finds the satisfaction of doing what he loves and transmitting that contagious energy to those around him. His dedication and love for his art are palpable in every note he plays, in every mix he creates, in every moment he shares with his audience. Being a DJ is not only his job, it is his vocation, his identity, and his reason for being.

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Chinese weddings in Panama have a millenary tradition. Today we could say that we are in the fifth generation or possibly sixth generation, and we try to continue with our cultures and traditions, among them, obviously, the wedding. The wedding is practically a whole day, starting at 5.00 a.m. and ending after midnight.

The night before, the bride and groom cannot see each other. Each must be at home. For the next day, the bride leaves her parents' house, as does the groom. The day and date of the wedding are chosen by someone who knows about astrology or by the elders of the family, who choose the day and a specific time.

From that moment on, the bride and her court are prepared, and that is where the ceremonies really begin, although many things have changed a little bit, but the most important thing in our culture is still the same: the main traditions.





As we mentioned, the wedding itself starts at 5.00 a.m. Here the bride and her court are prepared, and the first ceremony is the combing ceremony.

The combing ceremony: the oldest woman is chosen, the longest-lived of the family and who knows how to do it. In fact, it is to pass the comb in the bride's hair, since nowadays there are some Chinese Panamanians who do not know how to do it. For that reason, it is necessary to make sure that she also knows how the ceremonial act is, and it consists of 3 parts:

- 1. To be together until the end.
- 2. To have a home, children, grandchildren, and abundance.
- 3. To last a lifetime, until old age.

While the groom and his court prepare in a caravan to go to the bride's house, the route or tour is also chosen by the people who chose the day and time.





When the groom arrives at the bride's house, there is another ceremony, the penance ceremony, which consists of games and challenges that must be fulfilled. The idea is to make life impossible for the groom. All this is prepared by the bridesmaids beforehand. Both ladies and gentlemen of the court must be 3 to 5 each, the number must be odd, but never 7, nor even numbers.

Following this, the bride leaves her home where the lunch and social event will be held. In the afternoon, after lunch, the bride changes into a white dress, as used in the West.




At the end of the afternoon, the tea ceremony is held, usually at the groom's house. In this tea ceremony, the parents give an envelope with silver in a red envelope. From that moment on, they both call their in-laws mom and dad. This is a process of family integration. This ceremony consists of the bride and groom kneeling in front of both parents at the same time, showing their gratitude and love and the integration of both families into one.

The toast: the union of both families is made with the grandparents first, then the uncles and aunts; from the most distant to the closest, starting with the longest-lived.

The costume of both bride and groom is red, because it signifies fertility, it signifies everything good. Red is love. And in all good celebrations, both the bride and the groom wear red. In the morning, you wear the traditional Chinese red dress, and with that, all the ceremonies. And in the evening, the dress is changed again, that is, to the red dress, but much simpler, it is no longer the traditional one, this is for the toast and for the crazy hour the red one. After the end of the meal, the elders leave and the young people stay for the party.

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The boutonnière is an honor worn by the groom on his left lapel for the special recognition he has at the wedding by being the protagonist of a unique event. Like the bride's bouquet, the boutonnière is an achievement of the floral style as a distinction, it is ideally an extract of the most emblematic and beautiful flowers carried by the bride's bouquet. It can frame the traditional, classic or avant-garde style.

The boutonnière (a French word) is a distinctive feature of the ceremony. In addition to the groom, parents, groomsmen or witnesses, and gentlemen of the cortege may also wear it, and the designation will depend on the customs, religion and style by which the wedding is governed.

In Venezuela, we are accustomed to impose the boutonnière on the groom, parents of the bride and groom, godparents and gentlemen who are part of the procession according to the style of dress for that moment.

When we talk about honor, distinction and style, it is precisely because the protagonists in a wedding are of course the bride and groom and the people they have assigned to be the most important in the wedding. So there comes into play that distinction that is part of a complement to the groom's wardrobe. As it is a unique ceremony, all the elements involved must be special. In the timing of the wedding, the moment of delivery of the boutonnière should be noted as a point of honor of the protocol.



In a recent wedding I lived the experience of delivering a gift from the bride to the groom, it was a special jewel, a locket with the photo of his deceased father, which was to be placed in his boutonnière. It was my second wedding within the family, which made me know the emotionality it would generate in everyone. I imagined the moment that the groom's mother would place that distinctive and knowing what it would represent, I decided to order for her a rosary that included a locket with the same photo and so they could enter the ceremony together carrying a special memory of a loved one, it was a wonderful moment.

Everything that frames the organization of an event should be aimed at creating wonderful and unforgettable memories that will become great treasures.

Here are some useful recommendations on the use of the boutonnière

Special delivery and placement by the mother of the groom or the bridesmaid at the moment before leaving the groom's room.


- ÿ Document the placement of the boutonnière in photo or video.
- ÿ Have a second boutonnière in case of damage or loss.
- Ÿ Consider a discreet size and sober style for the boutonnière.
- Ÿ Take into account the texture of the suit to choose the boutonnière clasp if it is with piercing pin or requires a magnet.
- Y Take care of the boutonnière as well as the bouquet taking into account the weather when it is made with natural flowers.

6 top tips

- 1) Use the most elegant boutonnière.
- 2) Classic weddings: the boutonnière should be in composition with the bouquet.
- 3) Themed weddings: use an allusive pin.
- 4) Same-sex weddings for men: boutonnière should be in matching tones.
- 5) Avant-garde weddings: a goldsmith pin in composition with a brooch that the bride's bouquet should also have.
- 6) Trendy boutonnière: one that replaces the handkerchief with an elongated shape and is placed in the left pocket of the jacket.

The word *brindis* comes from the German expression *Bring dir*'s, "I offer it to you or I bring it to you", more or less. According to historians, the use of the word came to Spanish through the Italian language, after the German troops of the army of Charles V invaded Rome and celebrated their victory by raising their glasses shouting "Bring dir's".

Centuries ago, as today, there were those who enriched themselves illicitly, but with a marked difference, since more than fixing everything with bribes, they used a little poison to solve everything and in truth it was easier for them.

It was common to hear stories about impoverished kings marrying off their female daughters to some prince from a neighboring kingdom. The procedure was simple as it consisted of a large celebration, some poison, a glass of wine and finally death, for the bride's father. The fortune passed quickly from one hand to another. But do not think that this lasted long, as there were those who realized and the practice of



toasting fell into disuse, or contrary to what happens today, it became an act of total disregard.

For this reason, imagine the negative connotation of being invited to drink a toast, loaded with mistrust and malice.

Thus, if the one who invited to a toast had offered a poisoned cup, he would be finally imprisoned by his own poison, since when liquid splashed from the other cup he would probably die too, and poisons were so powerful that a drop was enough as a sample.

Although I always say that everyone can adopt the habits they like best, I consider it enough to make the gesture of raising the glass for the rest of the guests.

The best of good manners indicates that you only have to raise your glass slightly, making a positive gesture and looking quickly around with your eyes at everyone present without concentrating on just one person. I know very well that many times we enjoy the clash of our glasses with those of our table neighbors, especially if we are among friends.

If you were invited to my table, I would not advise it, as you will surely receive a quick lesson on how vulgar it is to shock them.

At the time of toasting, society is also accustomed to say some words such as salud, chin chin, salute, santé, and some daring ones shout foul language and vulgarities. The best thing to do is to refrain from shouting and to dedicate the toast with few words to the well-being of work, family, love or the anniversary in question.




